Family: Rosaceae

Origin: Horticultural

Hardiness zone: 3

Light requirement: Full sun

Height at maturity: 3 m

Spread at maturity: 2 m

Crown shape: Pyramidal

Fertility: Self-fertile

Spacing requirement from power lines: None

Growth rate: High

Common problems (disease, fungus, insects):
Prune dead branches in winter to avoid infection.

SPECIAL COMMENTS

Water thoroughly immediately after planting and during period of drought for the first few years following planting.
