Origin: Horticultural

Hardiness Zone: 6a

Light requirement: Full sun

Height at maturity: 8m

Spread at maturity: 6m

Tolerance to pollution: High

Common problems (disease, fungus, insects):
Average sensitivity to certain diseases and slight
sensitivity to certain insects.

SPECIAL COMMENTS

Inermis variety (thornless);
Spectacular flowering;
Resistant to leaf spots;
Ideal for small spaces.

LEAVES

Oval or obovate leaves;
Dark green in summer
and bronze green in fall.



FLOWERS

Produces star-shaped
corymbs;
Bright red with white
center;
Blooms in spring.



FRUITS

Red drupes by the
end of the summer,
attracting birds.
